

## Important Note for New Indigo Magic Desktop Users (Includes All Indy Systems)

When you install the IRIX Development Option (IDO) 5.1 on a system with the Indigo Magic desktop (this is the default configuration for all Indy systems), *inst* attempts to load an incompatible Motif product by default. The correct Motif product is included on your CD-ROM, but it must be loaded manually.

If you select the *motif\_dev* software from the */CDROM/dist* directory, you see the following message:

```
Inst> go
```

To load the correct product, follow these simplified steps. For instructions on software installation, refer to the *Indy Workstation Owner's Guide* (for Indy systems) or to the *IRIS Software Installation Guide*.

1. Insert the IDO option CD
2. Start *inst*
3. Do not select the *motif\_dev* subsystems from this directory. To ensure this, type:

```
keep motif_dev
```

4. Select the subsystems you want from the */CDROM/dist* directory.
5. Install the selected software.
6. At the *Inst>* prompt, type:

```
from /CD/dist/IndigoMagic
```

**Note:** *motif\_dev* is the only option in this directory.

7. Select the *motif\_dev* subsystems you want and install them.
